About the Cover – Pictured on the bulletin cover is the restored oil painting of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Child. Dates are a bit inexact but this painting hung over the side altar in 1866 to the mid-1880's when it was replaced by the statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This painting and its companion painting of St. Joseph and Child were then stored for about 120 years in the church basement. Dirt, tears, and the ravages of time have been repaired. They once again enliven our devotion to Our Lady, St. Joseph, and the Christ Child. In the lower left hand corner of each painting the artist wrote "Alcan fecit." Latin for "Alcan made this." Our painting of the Blessed Virgin Mary is based on an ancient icon attributed to St. Luke the Evangelist. Arriving in Rome in 390 AD, it is in the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome titled "Salus Populi Romani" (Protectress of the Roman People). Over the course of time, as an outgrowth of our 150th anniversary year, we hope to feature other sacred, artistic, and devotional works within the church that give us a foretaste of heaven.

Moses and Elijah represent the law and prophecy of the old covenant. When the voice from the cloud tells Peter, James and John to "listen to" Jesus, they will hear something new.
