Today, we welcome Fr. Thomas Blau, OP to St. Patrick at the onset of our parish mission. Father is a gifted Dominican friar and will be our mission preacher. The focus of a parish mission is to receive instruction in the truth of our Faith, conversion, and both rousing the indifferent and others to still greater holiness. Our focus will be on the core tenet of our Faith: Our Lord's Resurrection from the Dead.

This is different than our annual mission appeal, that is the apostolic activity of the Church in distant lands, the "mission field" for our parish mission is us, and all of London. 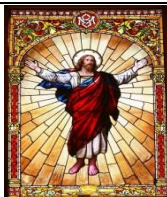
