About the Cover – Pictured on the bulletin cover is an emblem found at the top of one of our stained glass windows. What?!?! You say that you’ve never seen this one? Well, you just haven’t looked in the right place yet. 110 years ago you would have found this stained glass window and companion in the church itself. In 1909, St. Patrick’s Church was extended and enlarged causing the two windows to be removed but they were re-used elsewhere for the renovations. They are now in “The Upper Room” our parish’s museum. At one time, this room over the sacristy was used as a chapel for daily Mass. The window on the cover and eleven others similar in style were installed in the mid 1880’s during the pastorate of Fr. William D. Hickey replacing plain glass windows. We still have all twelve stained glass windows. This particular window depicts a monstrance (or ostensorium) both terms are based on Latin words meaning “to show.” A monstrance is the vessel used to display the Sacred Host during exposition and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The majority of emblems in these twelve windows are Eucharistic in nature. Over the course of time as an outgrowth of our 150th anniversary year, we hope to feature other artistic and devotional works within the church that give us a foretaste of heaven.-Dcn. Dan Hann
